Housecleaning

Basic housecleaning services include:

- Dusting & vacuuming
- Washing dishes
- Laundry & making beds
- Cleaning floors & bathrooms
- Washing indoor windows
- · Other light housecleaning tasks

Respite Care

Respite care is caregiver relief. Services include: An LPN provides routine foot care for

- · Home health care
- Basic house cleaning
- Meal preparation
- Social activities
- Other caregiver relief activities

Commission on Aging Outdoor Services

Seasonal maintenance services provided by Commission on Aging employees or vendors include:

Lawn Maintenance

Mowing and fall leaf removal

Snow Removal

- Plow driveways
- Shovel walkways
- Clear mailboxes

Windows

- Fall external washing
- Changing storm windows & screens

Transportation

A set amount of passes/coupons, offered on an annual basis. This program is available to clients at a discounted rate, prepayment is required. Transportation options include:

- BATA passes
- Taxi coupons

Emergency Financial Assistance

Available for financially qualified seniors

Home Health Care

Assistance with activities of daily living provided by Universal Aides including:

- · Bathing, hair, skin and oral care
- Observation of health status
- Changing of non-sterile dressings
- Monitoring vital signs
- Other personal care related activities

Foot Care

An LPN provides routine foot care for homebound clients. Services include:

- Soaking
- Buffing callouses
- · Nailtrimming and filing
- Foot exam & massage

Medication Units

 Units that store, dispense and remind clients to take their medications.

Personal Emergency Response Units

 Three types of units are available for use with landline and cellular telephones and a GPS based system.
With the press of a button units notify a 24/7 call center through the unit provided.

Medication Management

An LPN provides services including:

- Monitoring of medication dosage, time and effectiveness, therapeutic levels, compliance & side effects.
- Acts as liaison between prescribing providers and pharmacies.
